Meeting called at 7:30pm Danny Garza did the prayer, Bradley Gray the pledge and all council present.

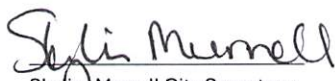

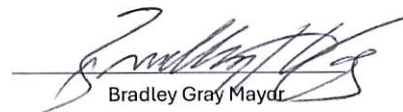
