Will make a cage to protect glass from foul ball. Bathrooms are set up and furnished. All plumbing and electrical is installed and just waiting on Oncor to connect power. Spray insulation still needs to be put in. We purchased all the equipment for the concession stand; Q Wilcox will be getting food and paper goods next week. With everything that is done, we have \$9500 remaining out of the \$150k budget. With what is left we are looking into a mini split system which is about \$1500. Looking into lights as well for the field so that games can be played at night. August 17th at 11 am, we are having a rededication ceremony for the field of the same person it was originally named after. Two teams from Murchison ISD are going to play a few innings. Two teams from 14U travel are going to play afterwards. Contractor assured he will be done by opening day. Bee Line is going to make banners for sponsors that donate to the field.
