

# November 11, 2022 Open Meeting Minutes

City of Murchison Open Meeting concerning canvassing the November election was held at City Hall November 22, 2022 at 5:00 pm.

In attendance were City Councilman Darrell Seidell, Brad Gray, Torance McClean and city secretary Trina Cloud.

Councilman Darrell Seidell read off the results of the November 8, 2022 city council election provided by Paula Ludtke -Elections administrator.

With 30/30 precincts reporting, 30/30 now complete.

Registered voters 402, ballots cast 203 and a total voter turnout of 50.50%.

The results are as follows:

Torance McClean received 105 total votes with 7 being absentee, 48 early votes and 50 votes on election day.

Jeremy Smith received 88 total votes with 4 being absentee, 26 early votes and 58 votes on election day.

Brad Gray received 106 total votes with 11 being absentee, 43 early votes and 52 votes on election day.

There were a total of 299 votes cast.

Torance McClean and Brad Gray were declared the winners and were duly sworn in by City secretary Trina Cloud.

Meeting closed at 5:32pm.
